

## **Voter Registration and Elections**

You may register to vote at the Town Clerk's office during normal business hours. The Supervisors of the Checklist hold sessions prior to an election. Their hours are posted in the local papers. You may also register at the polls the day of any election. You will be required to show proof of age, domicile and citizenship. A driver's license, passport or birth certificate is normally acceptable proof.

In order to vote in the Town of Sutton you must be domiciled in the Town of Sutton.

The Town of Sutton town voting is held at the Pillsbury Memorial Hall the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of March of each year with Town Meeting night being held the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of March each year following Town Voting. The Town Meeting is held at the Kearsarge Regional High School auditorium starting at 7:00 p.m. to end of business.

State and Federal elections are held as required by law.
